Dr. Harm Scherpbier is an advisor at Scherpbier.health and Starbridge Advisors LLC, partnering with Health IT firms on clinical system development, population health solutions, Analytics, and health IT implementation and strategy. Dr. Scherpbier is Adjunct Faculty at the Jefferson College of Population Health, teaching Health Informatics and Population Health Analytics. He is a member of the Leadership Team at the Philadelphia Health IT Circle.

Dr. Scherpbier was previously the Chief Medical Information Officer at Main Line Health, a 5-hospital Integrated Health Network near Philadelphia, PA, where he was responsible for the implementation of healthcare information systems and electronic patient records for physicians, nurses and other clinicians throughout the health system. He held positions in software engineering and product management at Siemens Health Services, CareScience, Aetna US Healthcare and SMS.

Dr. Scherpbier was born and raised in the Netherlands. He completed his medical training at the University of Groningen, and his MS in Medical Informatics from the Erasmus University of Rotterdam.
