

- 3. Operate as a <u>Shared Services (Health Directory, Active Care</u> Relationships, Security, Legal, Client Matching, etc.) as behind the scenes infrastructure





Current State

- There are many vendors that are not always able to easily exchange images with each other
- The current system creates a lot of burden on the providers
- The DICOM standard has some challenges associated with it and the metadata can vary
- There is no legislation requiring organizations to share images or header information in a central repository




Statewide Imaging Index



- A central directory for image centers and the available services/contact information
- A central registry of images available for a patient
 - Contain key information such as DICOM headers
 - Leverage existing statewide infrastructure to enhance patient matching
 - Avoid having to synchronize updates to images
- Potential to enhance CCDs with reference information for an image
