



## VIPR Release Notes

### December 2019

Great Lakes Health Connect is excited to release five new features to the Virtual Integrated Patient Record (VIPR) in December 2019. Feedback from VIPR users informed these changes.

VIPR users, VIPR Admins, and other individuals interested in the current state of the application are encouraged to review the information below. This document, as well as the training guides on the GLHC website ([www.gl-hc.org](http://www.gl-hc.org)), outlines and explains optimal use of the application.

### New Features (5)

1. Column Headings - The column headings on the Radiology & Other Results tab now better reflect the information and assist with locating specific results.
2. Search Encounters tab - Search the encounters tab using the new search bar at the top of the tab.
3. Hyperlink – Holland Hospital and Michigan State University Health Team provide radiology images to VIPR. To view the image, navigate to the Details of the Result. Prior to this update, the link to the image was plain text. The link is now a hyperlink. Click the link and the image will open on a new page of your web browser. The PIN is required to finalize access to the radiology image.
4. Hyperlink – The description of a Program is now a hyperlink instead of plain text. Click the link and the description will open on a new page of your web browser.
5. Split Screen – Easily view Patient Demographics, Allergy Information, and Patient Alias on a split screen view after clicking the corresponding icons.
