## **SDOH Use Case Data Validation:**

- Data validation is the practice of checking the integrity, accuracy and structure of data before it is used
- Data validation ensures that data maintained and moved by MiHIN is of high quality and conforms to MIHIN data standards
  - MIHIN is constantly working to align our standards with National standards
- All required fields and some optional fields will have data validation applied
  - CHAR or NUM fields with specific acceptable counts or formats outline the type of validation
- When a field does not pass data validation, an error message is generated and is sent to the email address that you advised was the point person during your onboarding.

## SDOH Use Case System Feedback E-mails




Submitters will receive an email if their SDOH submissions are not successfully processed.



Emails are sent to emails that are registered with MiHIN during your onboarding. Email notifications can be updated by submitting a request to the helpdesk.



The goal of this feature is to provide submitters with timely and detailed information to quickly understand and correct any file errors
